

The frames include Picatinny rails for mounting illumination and laser-aiming devices. An integrated trigger safety with a Reset Action System trigger requires positive finger pressure to operate the double-action-only design. - (a) Each state figure is an estimate based on data provided from a variety of sources including, but not limited to:
 State Police and State Attorney General office records. Several states issue CCW's by individual town and do not collect data on a statewide basis. Some duplication may occur in cases where individuals hold a separate CCW in several states simultaneously.
- (b) Some states, such as UT and FL have a high number of non-resident CCW holders due to that state honoring many other states' CCW's.
- * The eight "May Issue" states are: CA, DE, HI, MA, MD, NJ, NY, RI
- ** The two "Right Denied" states are: IL & WI
- *** The three "Unrestricted" states are: AK, AZ & VT
